This is volume 3 in the Series 'Publications of the de Nobili Research Library' under the editorship of Prof. G. Oberhammar of Vienna University. The Yatidharmaprakāśikā by Vāsudevāśrama, pupil of Govindāśrama and grandpupil of Rāmakṛṣṇāśrama, is an Advaitic work on Yatidharma, and is critically edited on the basis of six manuscripts. The introduction explains in detail the principles of textual criticism adopted. Appendix I gives an alphabetical list of all ritual formulae together with their identification and references. Appendix II gives an alphabetical list of all the half-verses, sūtra-s and prose passages. Appendix III contains a systematic index of the quotations. This is followed by a general index. The text is edited with meticulous care, and the Roman script is used.

On p. 28 jānum in the masculine is said to be an epic usage. But see the Kundamālā usage:

vāmena vānīratarum kareņa jānum samālambya ca dakṣiņena, pade pade me padam ādadhānā śanaiḥ śanair etu muhūrtam āryā.
